RECENT HIGHLIGHTS:

India: On March 12-21st Austin Richardson and my son, Thomas Dooley, accompanied me on my seventh ministry trip to India. It was their first trip to India, and we experienced several travel delays. While there I taught and spoke at the graduation ceremonies of two RIMI-affiliated seminaries in Bathinda, Punjab and in New Delhi. The message was on the theme of Joshua 1:9 regarding "Be Strong and Courageous". Since returning from this trip, PC made a financial contribution to RIMI to start an orphanage in Bathinda, coordinated by John Samuel. [www.rimi.org]

Insights on the Current Season: Two of my recent meditations: (1) It is Biblical for a church to meet in a home (Colossians 4:15). Therefore, be mindful that many disciples are choosing to participate in home-based churches. A church is not defined by a facility. This pattern of meeting in homes will continue to increase in the Western world; and (2) During an extended time of prayer and fasting in May, I petitioned the Lord to rise up in opposition of the ‘accuser of the brethren’. As His children we should request not only Yahweh’s mercy whenever we are *wrong*, but also His righteous judgments when we are *right*. “...*God’s judgment is right, and as a result you will be counted worthy of the kingdom of God... God is just: He will pay back trouble to those who trouble you and give relief to you who are troubled...*” (2 Thessalonians 1:5-7).

Georgia: On April 5-6th Laura and I traveled to LaFayette, GA, where I taught a youth group from Jessup, GA led by Stephanie, the daughter of Carlton & Dee Baxter.

Kickapoo Elder George Whitewater – The esteemed Elder of the Kickapoo Nation of Kansas, George Whitewater, died on June 9th, 2010. The 90-year old WW II veteran of multiple campaigns in Asia was regarded as the “Warrior Chief” among the Kickapoo. He and I had enjoyed a dialog about our spiritual dreams and visions of significance to the Kickapoo. This is of particular interest to me, as my maternal Great Grandfather, George Schuetz (1880-1948), had a close working relationship with the tribe, and in fact farmed on their reservation. On June 19th I was again in northeastern Kansas and planning to visit George to further our dialog about dreams and visions, when I learned of his death. On behalf of Path Clearer and my family, we honor the Kickapoo “Warrior Chief” George Whitewater.

Don Steward (AL) – In March Don traveled with Gerald Gann and Jerry Hopper to Greece/Macedonia and Romania. While in the Balkans they worked with Assemblies of God missionaries, Eddie and Patti White. The White's are Alabamians working with evangelical groups in Macedonia. The team assisted with some outreaches to the Gypsy population and met with key evangelical leaders from the region. Of special interest were visits to the archeological sites in Philippi, Greece and the birthplace of Mother Theresa in Skopje, Macedonia. While in Romania, Don and the team worked with Traian Lazea in a new church plant, a building dedication, worker ordinations, and water baptisms. Traian continues to work with the poor of Timisoara and is developing an outreach center on the outskirts of the city. This ministry is very deserving of prayers and support. Also they helped strengthen a congregation in Transylvania. *[Coincidentally, Tom Dooley had “seen” in a dream an airplane traveling eastward from Greece and “heard” that it was heading to Transylvania. This occurred prior to learning of the planned trip, and served as a confirming word in advance to Don.]*

Brian Francis Hume (VA) – Founder and President of Dominion Leadership Solutions, LLC, a business that perpetuates Christian-Judeo values within the field of leadership thought. Recently Brian partnered with Ecclesia College (their campus is based in Arkansas) to assist them in

Scott Bertoni (UT) – “For the past couple of months Yahweh has been speaking to me about ‘Paying the Price’ to know Him. As I was spending time in the Prayer Room of the Roi House of Prayer (R-HOP) in Ogden, Utah, it dawned on me that although each of us has been given different callings, gifting, talents, and circumstances, yet each of us is given the same amount of time each day (24 hours per day) in which to steward that which we’ve been entrusted with.
