

Launch of THE PATH<sup>TM</sup> Discipleship Ministry in September 2009: For the past decade I have noted a serious need to raise up and equip genuine *disciples* of Jesus. There are plenty of so-called *believers* or *Christians*. However, few of them are obedient and are confident of "the path" that they are to walk in life as a yielded disciple. Therefore, we are launching a new discipleship ministry called THE PATH<sup>TM</sup>, and in large part because the disciples of the 1<sup>st</sup> Century referred to themselves as "The Way". It will initially start in the Birmingham, Alabama area by the "home team" of Path Clearer. This prototype is being designed as a ministry model that can be "franchised" elsewhere later. It will emphasize the following PILLARS:

- Relational Mentoring (mature or maturing disciples leading others)
- Learning to Learn (e.g., using the Hebraic Beit Midrash style of Bible study)
- *Hearing from God* (logos + rhema training)
- *Influencing Nations with Truth* (e.g., travel with ministry teams)
- Bi-vocational Ministry in the Marketplace 24/7

The over-arching goal is the transformation of *believers* into bi-vocational *disciples* through a *Threshing Floor* environment that will emphasize growing up, obedience, following the Spirit, and commitment. The initial weekly meetings (e.g., *Learning to Learn*) will commence on Saturday evenings, and the first meeting is scheduled for **September 5**<sup>th</sup> in Birmingham. THE PATH will also host monthly weekend mentoring sessions, typically with invited guest mentors.

If you are located in North Central Alabama and desire to seriously pursue a relationship with Yahweh and have a teachable spirit, then you are invited to participate in THE PATH. Note that we are not particularly interested in passive pew sitters. Rather, we are looking for folks who are

serious about their relationship with the Lord. ## **INSIGHTS ON THE CURRENT SEASON:**

**Intercessory Alert – Obama & Conscription:** Near the beginning of this year I heard The Voice of the Lord say to me: "In the third quarter of 2009 Obama will consider a policy of reinstating conscription!" I have prayed about this serious rhema "word" for months and have shared it on occasions with other disciples to solicit intercession. I was particularly drawn to the term "conscription", which I knew was commonly referred to as the draft. But, I looked up the definition in Webster's and was surprised that it has <u>two</u> meanings: (1) compulsory enrollment of persons, especially for military service (draft); and (2) a forced contribution (as of money) imposed by a government in time of emergency (as war).

If you are breathing today and even slightly aware of what has been happening on Capitol Hill, you will note a clear connection between the Obama Adminstration and what has already begun to play out during the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter (July - September). I urge you therefore to pray and intercede. There are many dangerous policies being considered at this juncture on Capitol Hill, and the Lord has warned in advance. In Ezekiel 21:4, we are also warned that when God pronounced judgment on Judah, even the "innocent" *Righteous* would suffer along with the *Wicked*.

A "Dream" is not a Dream! A "Vision" is not a Vision! -- We have frequently heard the terms dream(s) and vision(s) in these days. Yet, I have observed plenty of blurring of the meanings of both of these terms, whether intentionally or inadvertently. There are two fundamental issues that need clarification. The first regards *precise use of terminology*! The second regards the *source of information*!

Let's go back to the basics -- In the Bible these two words have specific historic meanings, and in both cases relate to prophetic information or revelation delivered from God to a recipient. The terms used in the Hebrew Scriptures for "vision" are *hazon* and *mar'eh* (and their derivatives) and *mahazeh*. In the New Testament Greek language the terms are *horama* (and its derivative) or *optasia*. All of these Biblical terms for "vision" denote receiving divine or special revelation from the Holy Spirit, except wherever the text explicitly or implicitly states it is a false vision (e.g., from a false prophet).

A vision is typically received *while awake*. As the name implies, it is graphic in nature, but can also include other verbal (e.g., voices, songs, etc.) and nonverbal information (e.g., perceptions, physical sensations, sounds, imparted knowledge, etc.). Visions can have many forms, such as a still image, or moving picture, or a "trance" in which the recipient's natural surroundings seem to entirely disappear momentarily and he/she appears to be in an entirely different setting. Yet, each type of vision is happening while the recipient is consciously awake. It is as if one's spirit pierces through and overrides one's mind and sensory apparatus.

Many people often declare the following Scripture, "Where there is no <u>vision</u>, the people perish." (Proverbs 29:18; KJV). When I hear this phrase and the person's explanation, it is almost always misinterpreted as the plans or strategy from someone's cerebral mind. In this

Scripture, "vision" is *hazon* and means a literal graphic revelation from the Holy Spirit that was "seen" by the recipient, rather than a manmade plan or strategy!

The term "dream" in Scripture is *halom* (and its derivatives) in the Hebrew and *onar* (with one exception) in the New Testament Greek. These terms denote a literal dream *while* asleep and almost always denote receiving divine or special revelation from the Holy Spirit.

Furthermore, to round out the definitions of words used in the Bible, the term for "**revelation**" is also *hazon* (and its derivative) in Hebrew, which is the same term used for "vision" (above). In the New Testament the word "revelation" is the Greek term *apokalypsis*.

Therefore, the words "dream, vision, and revelation" in the Bible relate to God revealing information to us through the various means available to the Holy Spirit. This *language of the Spirit* typically extends beyond a recipient's natural thoughts or logic or plans. I earnestly caution you -- genuine revelatory visions and dreams often have very little to do with rational logic! The *language of the Spirit* often defies our natural understanding within the cerebral mind, and the revelatory information can be either symbolic or literal in meaning.

Note the irony of a PhD scientist-entrepreneur writing this! I am not merely writing about Biblical terminology and insights, for I have also had many personal experiences as a recipient of revelatory information, and most often in dreams.

So from a Biblical context, the terms vision(s) and dream(s) are NOT about us having a desire or a goal or conceiving of a plan. However, I've observed that most folks in the West have the opposite impression. They confuse, "I <u>have</u> a dream" (i.e., a desire, a goal, or a plan) with "I <u>had</u> a dream" (i.e., a literal dream -- an unconscious revelation while asleep). They also confuse, "I <u>have</u> a vision" with "I <u>had</u> a vision" in a similar fashion. They are not the same thing. In these common cases what they really mean is that they have their own personal goal or plan to achieve some objective.

Please don't get me wrong. Having a goal, a plan, or a strategy to achieve something is commendable, prudent, and practical. We're admonished in the Scriptures about living wisely with ample counsel and adequate planning. But, just don't use the wrong terminology to describe it. Simply use the more precise terminology and say "I have a goal and a plan", or "I have a strategy to achieve something." They are not the same thing as dream(s) or vision(s) in the Bible.

When using these two terms we need to also understand the *source of information*. To be concise we're considering whether this dream or vision was from God or from another source (e.g., self). When speaking from the *Biblical perspective* with Biblical terminology about vision(s) and dream(s), we're talking about divine revelation from God as the source, not merely as a good plan conceived by the cognition of men, women, or children. As disciples of Christ we should earnestly seek to be led by Yahweh's revelation and not by our own opinions and ideas, be they ever so wonderful.

[One caveat to note is that some dreams and visions can come from sources other than God. So, training in the *gift of prophecy*, and being accountable, and remaining affiliated with discerning and/or prophetic individuals are also necessary. I have written a bit on this topic in my books.]

So why walk through this narrative about *terminology* and the *source of information*? Many ministries are led today by manmade "visions" and "dreams" that were not revelatory in nature. Many ministries and churches are built upon success-driven formulas and business models with limited Biblical precedent and often little or no divine or special revelation. The plans might be OK. They might even be better than the plans of other ministries. But, they are

still man's plans, not God's optimal plans based upon a Biblical paradigm and prophetic insight. These ministries were conceived in the minds of man, not via the Spirit of the Living God.

In contrast, according to Ephesians 2:20 the foundation of the genuine Church was (and still is) built upon Jesus as the Cornerstone along with prophets and apostles, and the latter of whom were (and still are) prophetic. "For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy." (Revelation 19:10b). So, the *leadership foundation* of the genuine Church is entirely prophetic.

Yet, many local churches and ministries lack the prophetic (i.e., revelatory gifts and prophetic callings) in their leadership and functioning. Some folks even go so far as to quench it, reject it, renounce it, and curse it. Woe, be that man or woman. May God extend his long-suffering mercy to them. We need local churches and ministries to embrace the model of the 1<sup>st</sup> Century Church and to establish or re-establish the tripartite prophetic *leadership foundation*. It just isn't optimal to have a pastor with good intentions (who typically lacks a revelatory gift and prophetic calling) saying, "Follow me! I have a dream! I have a vision!" That is how the kingdoms of men are established, not the Kingdom of God.

In conclusion, a "dream" is not a dream! A "vision" is not a vision!
