Insights Concerning Hurricane Katrina:

Hi PC Friends,

In view of the tragic news out of the Gulf Coast and especially New Orleans, friends have asked for any insights about the nature of the events there on the coast, and what might God be speaking at present. So, what has He been saying? I believe that God has been speaking by rhema revelation of the Holy Spirit for months and years leading up to this time and to many prophetic individuals. For your consideration several of the PC newsletters since the fall of 2004 have indicated highly relevant insights about the "signs of the times" we've entered:

(1) We are in a season of serious warnings concerning natural and man-made dangers, a great ***shaking of the nations*** and especially for the three years of 2005-2007 (and commencing during the fall of 2004). The warnings are meant to stir in us a willingness toward humility, repentance, and trusting the sovereign hand of God in spite of the circumstances. The purposes are to *"turn your eyes upon Jesus"* and to challenge common misconceptions in Judeo-Christian theology about God's sovereignty even over the "adverse" elements of nature;

(2) A ***spirit of confusion*** was formerly released and it is being followed by a ***spirit of hopelessness*** at present and in the days to follow. Note the confirmation of the *"spirit of confusion"* in the attachment below by Rick Joyner. Also note that last year I was prompted by God to begin writing a new book entitled ***"Hope When Everything Seems Hopeless"***. It is half written at present. Perhaps the writing of it needs to be hastened!

(3) The US State Department under the leadership of Condi Rice has been very forceful regarding the "Roadmap for Peace" for Israel and Palestine. I believe that Miss Rice, the State Department, and others in leadership in Washington have provided unwise and unbiblical counsel to the Bush administration. They have pressured Israel to give up some of "their" *costal land*. Therefore, one *might* speculate that there is a possible link to the Hurricane season that commenced in 2004 (and included Hurricane Ivan last fall) that has been attacking the *costal lands* in the USA, and has culminated in the devastation of this past week in Louisiana, Mississippi, and Alabama. While on *Revelation TV* in the UK and Europe on Monday August 15th, we discussed various Scriptures pertaining to the Biblical borders of Israel in the context of the Gaza pull out that started that week and concluded the following week immediately prior to Hurricane Katrina. In January 2004

God revealed to me that we had entered a new season entitled the "*Eye of the Needle of the Hurricane*". Then a sharp rise in the incidence of hurricanes arrived and the literal eye of Hurricane Ivan passed near Mobile Bay and directly over Birmingham that fall.

Prior to waking up on Sunday morning August 28th (the day prior to the arrival of the hurricane), I had an interesting spiritual dream. Note that I've had "similar" revealing dreams of this type within 24 hours prior to the 9/11 Islamist attack (2001) and the Indian Ocean Tsunami (2004). So, I seriously pondered it to understand its meaning. In the dream a few of my friends are with me at a type of large "stadium". We witness a huge crowd of people panic after a "pulse" of energy was released in that city. Many people died on the streets next to the tall stadium, trying to escape. The prepared food was no longer edible. However, we didn't panic -- we simply waited patiently while others were making foolish hasty decisions causing their own deaths, knowing that time would permit us to get out later. In the final scene a TV crew interviewed me, and the reporter asked:

- "What could have been done to prevent this and future incidents?"
- "Should we rebuild?" – If I recall correctly I replied, "No."
- Then I concluded with an odd comment, which I didn't understand until later this week, "Look to the railroads as valuable."

A concern in my spirit with regard to railroads is that the grains harvested from the Great Plains and the natural materials shipped down the Mississippi River will likely need to follow alternative paths to market. Pray *in favor* of establishment of effective routes of commerce to bypass the dependency on the Mississippi River (e.g., railroads).

If you were not already aware of it, consider some of the spiritual forces of darkness surrounding New Orleans in particular and the neighboring coastal region in general, including Biloxi, MS and Mobile, AL. Those strongholds of sin include Afro-Caribbean Voodoo and occult witchcraft, gambling, sexual perversion, Mardi Gras, corrupt "authorities", alcohol and drug abuse, and pursuit of various types of hedonistic pleasures (e.g., hobbies as idols). Consider these facts about the region during your times of prayer over this crisis in the Gulf Coast. When the thin veneer of "civility" is lifted off of any community, the demonic influences of the region run rampant, exposing the root evils of their nature. Note the demonic spirits of anarchy, rebellion against authority, lawlessness, and rage in New Orleans following the flood. This was formerly partially veiled from sight, but has since been revealed in the light once restraint was lifted. That is a good thing. In particular especially note the seriousness of the impact of a dispersion of practitioners of Voodoo and witchcraft outside of New Orleans. Thus, please pray effectively *against* an anticipated *witchcraft diaspora*. May God genuinely "cleanse" these regions of sin's strongholds as a result of Hurricanes Katrina and Ivan.

It is understandable that almost everyone in the U.S. is now very focused on the tragedy caused by Hurricane Katrina. It is a tragedy that will touch us all in many ways and will continue to unfold over the weeks and months ahead. Even so, the end result is that we are going to be much better and much stronger as a nation. The Gulf Coast region will also emerge better than ever, and stronger.

Even so, we were not prepared for this as a nation, and we do need to learn the lessons that this situation is going to teach us. As this plays out it will prove to have been even more deadly and devastating than almost anyone imagined, even though it is already perceived to be the worst natural disaster in our history. Even so, it could have been worse, and the end result will be to help us.

I have been asked often if anyone in our ministry or our prophetic friends foresaw Hurricane Katrina. The answer is 'yes,' as early as 1998. These prophecies included 'New Orleans looking like an estuary,' and great damage coming to Mobile and all parts in-between. As hard as this could be to imagine now, the end result of this storm will be to make even many of the Gulf Coast victims thankful for it in the end.

Over the next few years a great move of God will spread over that region, and many who have lost all of their possessions will gain something far better eternal life. This storm is a sign of a great cleansing and very powerful move of God coming to that region which will affect the whole nation for good. We will also see it affecting us in more difficult ways for a time<especially economically. However, the region will be rebuilt and better than before, but much more than physically, it will be rebuilt spiritually. There is a great move of God to rebuild our nation spiritually as well.

Though there are many crucial lessons to be learned from this entire situation, it is not the time to get into them in any more depth. Now it is still a rescue situation, and we need to pray that this now be accomplished with Godspeed or many, many more could be lost.

One reason the situation has not been handled better is the **spirit of confusion** that has been released over that region. We know that we do not war against flesh and blood (see Ephesians 6:12), though we cannot expect the government and law enforcement agencies to understand this. There is a lot of witchcraft coming from New Orleans and it wants to cause as much death as possible. We need to pray for this spirit of confusion to be bound, and for great clarity and energy to be given to those who are managing and implementing the lifesaving efforts. Then we need to pray for great clarity and energy to rebuild that city and region. This is important for the whole nation.

The church needs to gear up to help in many ways. Churches are called sanctuaries, and we need to be that right now for these multitudes who have virtually lost everything they had. If every church just took one family, we could take care of all of the people. There are churches all over America with large Sunday School facilities that only get used one half a day a

week. These can be quickly converted to shelters for families.

We are also at this time examining every way that we can use the facilities that we have at Heritage International Ministries to help those in need. We need to all be asking right now what we have that could help. Many things that we no longer use and will never use again, such as old clothes, tools, vehicles, or other resources can make a big difference in the lives of those who are our neighbors and are now in desperate need.
